 - Early, mid & late season varieties
 - Everbearers
- Trial field for testing new raspberry varieties





- Freshplants / Potted Freshplants
- Waitingbed Plants
- Trayplants





Frigoplants

Recommendation:



(A-) Plants 8-10mm

- Open field production
- Early planting for a harvest in the following year
- Flowers should be taken out



Frigoplants

Recommendation:



(A) Plants 10-15mm

- Open field production
- Small harvest is possible in the first year
 - => One truss inside (~100-150g)
 - => Main crop in the following year
- Later planting is possible



Frigoplants



Recommendation:

(A+) plants 15mm+

- 60 day production, open field
- Second crop in the following year
- 2-3 trusses inside (200-300g)



Freshplants



- Bare rooted fresh plants
 - => Lifted all by hand
- Potted fresh plants






Freshplants (bare root)

Recommendation:



- Open field production
 - => Early production
- Tunelproduction
 - => for planting in the soil



Freshplants

Recommendation:



- Open field production
 - => Early production
 - => Good on raised beds, vlies covering
- Tunnelproduction
 - => For planting in substrate





Waiting Bed Plants

Recommendation:



- 60 Day Culture
 - => Open field production
 - => Tunnelproduction
 - Soil / Substrate
 - => Glashouse production



Medium Waiting Bed => ~4-6 trusses (~500g)

TrayPlants

Recommendation:



- 60 Day Culture
 - Tunnelproduction
 - soil / substrate
 - Glashouse production
 - ~5-6 trusses (~500-600g)

- Most early variety
- Very good taste
- Good yield, needs very intensive treetment with water and fertilieser
- Suitable for direct marketing and also supermarkets
- Blossoms are above the leaves, be careful with frost

Allegro (FF 1602)




- New early variety from Fresh Forward
- Good yield, good fruit quality
- Very good taste
- Early variety for all marketing systems
- Strong growing and healthy plant



Malling Centenary

Malling Centenary

- Extraordinary fruit qualities. (96% class 1)
- Very good shelf life
- Low picking costs
- Susceptible for Phytophthora Cactorum





Aprica



Aprica

- High yield, good fruit size, high percentage class 1
- Good Sehlf Life, Easy to pick
- Poor taste => Wholesale market only!
- Healthy plant
- Blossoms are under the leaves

New Variety:

Renaissance



- New main season variety from Hansa Bred
- Good yield, medium sized berries
- Extraordenary taste
- Mid harvest period
- Soft fruit
- Interest for production and pastry shops



Sonata




Sonata

- High yield, good fruit size,
- Good taste
- Susceptable for ph.cactorum & botrytis
- Variety for direct sellings & supermarkets

New Variety:

Sonsation



- New main season variety from Flevo Berry
- Good yield, good fruit quality
- Very good taste
- Low susceptibility for ph.cactorum & botrytis




Faith

- attractive fruit, high percetage class 1
- good taste
- for all markets

Magnus



- New late variety from Flevo Berry
- Good yield and good fruit quality
- Medium taste
- Late variety more for wholesale market

- very late variety
- very good taste
- medium shelf life
- for direct sellings (extends the season for 2 weeks)

New Variety:

Malga (Everbearer)



- New everbearer from F. Zenti, Italy
- Early Blossoms
- Orange-red fruit
- Good fruit quality

New Variety:

Murano (Everbearer)



- New everbearer variety from CIV, Italy
- Attractive fruit
- Good balance between taste and yield
- Healthy variety

Possible Cultivation



Production in the Tunel: 10-20% more yield and better fruit quality!






Glen Ample / Tulameen (Floricane)

- Cultivation in tunnel recommended




Different cultivars for a long raspberry season
